EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE
OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY ROAD (ADR)

GENEVA, 30 SEPTEMBER 1957

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY PORTUGAL
TO ANNEXES A AND B, AS AMENDED¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.482.2006.TREATIES-1 of 1 July 2006, concerning the amendments proposed by Portugal to annexes A and B, as amended to the above Agreement, communicates the following:

On 27 September 2006, the Government of Switzerland notified the Secretary-General of its objection to the above amendments as indicated in depositary notification C.N.804.2006.TREATIES-2 of **22 January 2007**.

By 1 October 2006, that is to say, on the expiry of the period of three months, no further objection had been notified to the Secretary-General. Consequently, the amendments have been deemed accepted in accordance with article 14 (3) of the Agreement and will enter into force three months after the date of acceptance, i.e., on 1 January 2007.
