ENTRY INTO FORCE OF ANNEX G¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

With reference to depositary notification C.N.242.2006.TREATIES-6 of 27 March 2006 transmitting the adopted text of Annex G, none of the Parties to the Convention have notified the Secretary-General of the non-acceptance of Annex G within the period of one year from the date of its circulation. In accordance with paragraphs 3 (b) and (c) of article 22 of the Convention, the Annex G entered into force for all Parties to the Convention which have not submitted a notification of non-acceptance within the above stipulated one year period, that is on 27 March 2007.
