ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 32<sup>1</sup>

Regulation No. 32 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance  
with paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be  
adopted and are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 32 as of 11 June 2007.
