CONVENTION ON ROAD SIGNS AND SIGNALS

VIENNA, 8 NOVEMBER 1968

PROPOSAL OF CORRECTIONS TO THE CONVENTION, AS AMENDED

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The attention of the Secretary-General has been drawn to certain apparent errors in the English, French and Russian texts of the Convention, as amended.

The text of the proposed corrections (doc.TRANS/WP.1/2003/3/Rev.4/Corr.1) in the English, French and Russian languages, can be accessed on the website of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe at the following address:

In accordance with the established depositary practice, and unless there is an objection to effecting a particular correction from a signatory State or a contracting State, the Secretary-General proposes to effect the above corrections in the English, French and Russian texts of the Convention, as amended.

Any objection should be communicated to the Secretary-General no later than 17 January 2008, i.e., within 90 days from the date of the present notification.
