AUSTRALIA: NOTIFICATION OF DISAGREEMENT UNDER ARTICLE 1 (2)  
OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification  
C.N.558.2007.TREATIES-1 of 9 May 2007 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the  
Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the following Draft Regulation<sup>1</sup>:

“Uniform provisions concerning the approval of partitioning systems to protect passengers  
against displaced luggage, supplied as non-original equipment”,

the Government of Australia notified, on 6 September 2007, its disagreement with the said draft  
Regulation. Therefore, in accordance with article 1 (4) of the Agreement, the above-mentioned  
Regulation will not enter into force for Australia on the date of its adoption.
