ANNEX 8 TOGETHER WITH PROPOSALS TO INTRODUCE NEW EXPLANATORY NOTES
8.13.1-3 AND 8.13.2 TO ANNEX 6 OF THE CONVENTION¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

By 1 October 2008, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention had
communicated an objection to the Secretary-General. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions
of article 60 (1) of the Convention, the amendments will enter into force on 1 January 2009 for all
Contracting Parties.
