AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP)

Proposal of Corrections to the proposed amendments to annex $1\ \mbox{of the atp}^1$

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

With reference to depositary notification C.N.191.2009.TREATIES-1 of 2 April 2009 concerning the proposal of Amendments to Annex 1 of the ATP, the Working Party on the Transport of Perishable Foodstuffs of the United Nations Commission for Europe (UNECE) informed the Secretary-General of certain corrections effected with respect to the text of document ECE/TRANSP/WP.11/218/Add/1.
