CAMBODIA: NOTIFICATION¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 18 November 2009, the Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia notified the Secretary-General that the Government wished to change the distinctive letter “**K**”, previously submitted to the Secretary-General in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3 of Annex 4 of the above Convention¹, to a new distinguishing sign “**KH**”.
