CANADA: ACCEPTANCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEXES A, B AND C OF THE  
CONVENTION<sup>1,2</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 4 January 2011.

The Amendments to Annexes A, B and C of the Convention will enter into force for Canada on  
4 April 2011 in accordance with article 22 (4) which reads as follows:

“The proposal, adoption and entry into force of amendments to Annex A, B or C shall be  
subject to the same procedures as for the proposal, adoption and entry into force of additional annexes  
to this Convention, except that an amendment to Annex A, B or C shall not enter into force with respect  
to any Party that has made a declaration with respect to amendment to those Annexes in accordance  
with paragraph 4 of Article 25, in which case any such amendment shall enter into force for such a Party  
on the ninetieth day after the date of deposit with the depositary of its instrument of ratification,  
acceptance, approval or accession with respect to such amendment.”
