BOLIVIA (PLURINATIONAL STATE OF): DENUNCIATION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

On 29 June 2011, the Government of Bolivia (Plurinational State of) deposited with the Secretary-General an instrument of denunciation of the above Convention. (Reference is made to depositary notification C.N.403.1976.TREATIES-2 of 18 January 1977 concerning the accession by Bolivia to the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961, as amended by the Protocol amending the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961.)

The denunciation shall take effect for Bolivia (Plurinational State of) on 1 January 2012 in accordance with article 46 (2) of the above Convention which reads as follows:

“The denunciation, if received by the Secretary-General on or before the first day of July in any year, shall take effect on the first day of January in the succeeding year, and, if received after the first day of July, shall take effect as if it had been received on or before the first day of July in the succeeding year.”
