ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEX 6 AND TO ANNEX 9, PART I<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

By 1 October 2011, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention had communicated to the Secretary-General an objection to the proposals of amendments to Annex 6 and Annex 9, Part I, to the Convention, which were adopted by the Administrative Committee for the 1975 TIR Convention of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) at its fifty-first session, held in Geneva on 3 February 2011. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions of article 60 (1) of the Convention, the amendments will enter into force on 1 January 2012 for all Contracting Parties.
