ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 64¹

Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification
C.N.670.2011.TREATIES-1 of 13 October 2011, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation
No. 64 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with
paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and
are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 64 as of 13 April 2012.
