RULE NO. 2. UNIFORM PROVISIONS FOR PERIODICAL TECHNICAL INSPECTION OF WHEELED VEHICLES WITH REGARD TO THEIR ROADWORTHINESS

ENTRY INTO FORCE<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification C.N.506.2011.TREATIES-2 of 2 August 2011 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the above rule, none of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement notified its disagreement with the draft rule. Therefore, in accordance with article 2 (1) of the Agreement, the draft rule has been adopted as Rule No. 2 annexed to the above Agreement. The date of entry into force for all Contracting Parties is 3 February 2012, pursuant to article 2 (3) of the Agreement.
