REGULATION NO. 129. UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE
APPROVAL OF ENHANCED CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEMS USED ON BOARD
OF MOTOR VEHICLES

ENTRY INTO FORCE OF REGULATION NO. 129¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification
C.N.716.2013.TREATIES-XI.B.16 of 9 January 2013 (reissued for technical reasons on 16 January
2013) by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the Governments of the Contracting Parties the text
of the draft regulation, two Contracting Parties to the Agreement notified their disagreement with the
draft regulation². Accordingly, in accordance with article 1 (3) of the Agreement, the draft regulation is
adopted as Regulation No. 129 annexed to the above Agreement. In accordance with article 1 (4) of the
Agreement, the date of entry into force for all Contracting Parties, except for Australia and Japan,
is 9 July 2013.
