
JAPAN: NOTIFICATION OF DISAGREEMENT UNDER ARTICLES 1(2) AND (4)  
OF THE AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification  
C.N.1019.2013.TREATIES-XI.B.16 of 17 December 2013, by which the Secretary-General transmitted  
to the Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the Draft Regulation entitled “Uniform  
provisions concerning the approval of motor vehicles with regard to their reusability, recyclability and  
recoverability”, the Government of Japan notified, on 11 April 2014, its disagreement with the said  
draft Regulation.

Therefore, in accordance with article 1(4) of the Agreement, the above-mentioned Regulation  
will not enter into force for Japan in the event of its adoption.
