JAMAICA: LATE RESERVATION¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:


The above action was lodged on 6 February 2014.

“The Government of Jamaica does not consider itself bound by the provisions of Paragraph 1
of Article 23 of the International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism.”

In keeping with the depositary practice followed in similar cases, the Secretary-General proposes to receive the reservation in question for deposit in the absence of any objection on the part of one of the Contracting States, either to the deposit itself or to the procedure envisaged, within a period of one year from the date of the present notification. In the absence of any such objection, the said reservation will be accepted for deposit upon the above-stipulated one year period, that is on 6 February 2015.
