EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE WORK OF CREWS OF
VEHICLES ENGAGED IN INTERNATIONAL ROAD TRANSPORT (AETR)

GENEVA, 1 JULY 1970

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY TURKEY AND UKRAINE TO
ARTICLE 14 OF THE AETR

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.136.2015.TREATIES-XI.B.21 of 18 February 2015 concerning the amendment proposed by Turkey and Ukraine to article 14 of the Agreement, communicates the following:

Following the communication received from the Kingdom of the Netherlands on 5 April 2016¹, the amendment, in accordance with paragraphs 5 and 6 of article 21, is deemed to have been accepted and will enter into force on 5 July 2016.
