CONVENTION ON THE RIGHTS OF THE CHILD  
NEW YORK, 20 NOVEMBER 1989

ITALY: OBJECTION TO THE RESERVATIONS MADE BY SOMALIA UPON RATIFICATION<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 23 September 2016.

“The Government of the Italian Republic has carefully examined the reservations made by the Federal Republic of Somalia on October 1, 2015 to the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

The Italian Republic considers that the reservations made by the Federal Republic of Somalia regarding articles 14, 20 and 21 of the Convention on the Rights of the Child are incompatible with the object and purpose of the Convention and therefore objects to them.

This objection shall not preclude the entry into force of the Convention between the Federal Republic of Somalia and the Italian Republic.”
