CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC  
GENEVA, 19 SEPTEMBER 1949

PROPOSAL OF AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES 8 AND 22<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

By 3 March 2016, on the expiry of a period of four months following the date on which the proposed amendments to articles 8 and 22 of the above-mentioned Convention were communicated by depositary notification C.N.549.2015.TREATIES-XI.B.1 of 3 November 2015, no reply was received from the Contracting Parties.

Consequently, neither alternative (a) nor alternative (b) has received the number of favourable replies required under paragraphs 2 and 5 of article 31 of the Convention. Neither has any Contracting Party favoured the alternative set out in paragraph 1 (c) of article 31.

The above-mentioned proposal of amendments to articles 8 and 22 of the Convention is therefore deemed not to have any effect.
