NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs of the United Nations Secretariat and, pursuant to article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, taking into account the information contained in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, of 1 March 2017, has the honour to convey the following:

- Supreme Decree No. 074-2017-PCM was issued on 12 July 2017.<sup>1</sup>
- Through the supreme decree, the state of emergency in the district of Tuman, Province of Chiclayo, Department of Lambayeque was extended by a period of thirty (30) calendar days, computed as of 13 July 2017.
- During the state of emergency declared through the supreme decree, rights relating to liberty and security of person, inviolability of the home, and freedom of assembly and movement within the territory set out in articles 9, 17, 21 and 12 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights were suspended.
- The present extension of the state of emergency is intended to prevent a serious breakdown of law and order, as well as any demonstrations or criminal offences that might be committed in said area.
