AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES 25 AND 26 OF THE CONVENTION ON THE  
PROTECTION AND USE OF TRANSBOUNDARY WATERCOURSES AND  
INTERNATIONAL LAKES

MADRID, 28 NOVEMBER 2003

SENEGAL: ACCEPTANCE <sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 31 August 2018.

The Amendments will enter into force for Senegal on 29 November 2018 in accordance with  
article 21 (4) of the Convention, which reads as follows:

“An amendment to the present Convention shall be adopted by consensus of the  
representatives of the Parties to this Convention present at a meeting of the Parties and shall enter into  
force for the Parties to the Convention which have accepted it on the ninetieth day after the date on  
which two thirds of those Parties have deposited with the Depositary their instruments of acceptance of  
the amendment. The amendment shall enter into force for any other Party on the ninetieth day after the  
date on which that Party deposits its instrument of acceptance of the amendment.”
