MEXICO: WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTION TO THE RESERVATION MADE BY THE  
PLURINATIONAL STATE OF BOLIVIA UPON ACCESSION <sup>1</sup>

communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 30 November 2018.

... the Permanent Mission of Mexico to the United Nations wishes to inform, for any relevant purposes, that, having made a comprehensive assessment of the recent developments in multilateral discussions on the subject of drugs, the Government of Mexico has decided to withdraw the objection to the reservation made by the Plurinational State of Bolivia upon accession to the Convention, submitted by Mexico on 9 January 2013 and communicated in depositary notification C.N.85.2013.TREATIES-VI.18...
