INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON ARREST OF SHIPS, 1999  
GENEVA, 12 MARCH 1999

TURKEY: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 11 September 2019, with:

Declaration (Original: English and Turkish)

“Pursuant to article 8 of this Convention, Turkey declares that she reserves the right to give priority to the provisions of 1926 International Convention for the Unification of Certain Rules concerning the Immunity of State-owned Vessels and Additional Protocol to [it] signed on 24 May 1934, both of which Turkey is a Party to.”

The Convention entered into force for Turkey on 11 December 2019 in accordance with its article 14 (2) which reads as follows:

“For a State which expresses its consent to be bound by this Convention after the conditions for entry into force thereof have been met, such consent shall take effect three months after the date of expression of such consent.”
