The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, in his capacity as depositary of the ICCPR, and with reference to its Note Verbale of 18 March 2020 (no. USA-ONU/330/150/2020) notifying the declaration of the state of emergency and the exercise by the Republic of Moldova of the right of derogation from certain obligations under the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, has the honour to inform that the state of emergency in the Republic of Moldova has expired on May 15, 2020, thus bringing to an end the derogations announced by the Republic of Moldova from articles 12 and 21 of the Covenant.

Pursuant to Article 4 (3) of the Covenant, the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova kindly asks for this communication be considered as a notification on the termination of the derogations.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of its highest consideration.
