“... the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland hereby
extends the application of the United Kingdom’s ratification of the Convention to the territory of the
Cayman Islands, for the international relations of which the United Kingdom is responsible.

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland considers the
extension of the Convention to the territory of the Cayman Islands will take effect on the date of deposit
of this notification.”
