HONDURAS: LATE RESERVATIONS AND DECLARATION 1

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 6 February 2020, the following reservations and declaration, which the Government of Honduras had intended to make upon accession to the Convention, were lodged by the Government of Honduras with the Secretary-General:

RESERVATIONS

The Republic of Honduras does not consider itself bound by the following provisions of the articles and annexes contained in the Convention on Road Traffic:

- 1. Chapter IV, article 41, paragraph 5, relating to the second annex 6 to the 1968 Convention on Road Traffic, which in its paragraphs 8 and 9 contains the categories DE and D1E concerning units for the carriage of persons that can be coupled to a trailer.
- 2. Article 30, paragraph I, relating to annex 6, paragraphs 8 and 9, on weights expressly stipulated as maximum masses.
- 3. Annex 1, paragraph 1, relating to annex 5, chapter II, paragraph 42, concerning vehicle dimensions.
- 4. Chapter IV, article 41, subparagraphs (b) and (c), concerning the minimum age for obtaining a permit for the first time.

DECLARATION

The Republic of Honduras shall, with respect to the above-mentioned partial reservations, apply the provisions of articles 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 28 and 35, paragraph 2, and the other applicable provisions concerning vehicle dimensions contained in the Central American Agreement on Road Traffic.

(XI.B.19) - 2 -

In keeping with the depositary practice followed in similar cases, the Secretary-General proposes to receive the reservations and declaration in question for deposit in the absence of any objection on the part of one of the Contracting States, either to the deposit itself or to the procedure envisaged, within a period of one year from the date of the present notification. In the absence of any such objection, the said reservations and declaration will be accepted for deposit upon the expiration of the above-stipulated one year period, i.e. on 19 February 2021.
