EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE WORK OF CREWS OF
VEHICLES ENGAGED IN INTERNATIONAL ROAD TRANSPORT (AETR)

GENEVA, 1 JULY 1970

ACCEPTANCE OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 14 OF THE AETR¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary communication C.N.520.2020.TREATIES-XI.B.21 of 6 November 2020, concerning the amendment proposed to Article 14 of the AETR, communicates the following:

On 5 November 2020, the Government of the Netherlands notified the Secretary-General, pursuant to article 21 (2) (b) of the Agreement, that although it intended to accept the proposal to amend the Agreement as mentioned above, the conditions necessary for such acceptance were not yet fulfilled.

In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 2 to 5 of article 21 of the Agreement, the proposed amendment to the AETR is deemed accepted only if before the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of the period of six months as indicated in the said article, the Government of the Netherlands did not notify an objection to the proposed amendment.

By 23 January 2022, that is to say, on the expiry of the period of nine months following the expiry of the period of six months as indicated in depositary notification C.N.473.2020.TREATIES-XI.B.21 of 23 October 2020, the Government of the Netherlands did not submit any objection.

Consequently, the amendment has been deemed accepted. In accordance with article 21 (6), it will enter into force three months after the date of acceptance, i.e., on 23 April 2022.
