ENTRY INTO FORCE OF UNITED NATIONS REGULATION No. 165 <sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification  
C.N.173.2022.TREATIES-XI.B.16 of 19 July 2022 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the  
Governments of the Contracting Parties the text of draft United Nations Regulation No. 165, one (1) of  
the Contracting Parties to the Agreement (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)  
notified the Secretary-General of its intention not to apply the said United Nations Regulation on the  
date of its entry into force, pursuant to paragraphs 3 and 4 of article 1 of the Agreement.

Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 3 of article 1 of the Agreement, the draft United  
Nations Regulation is adopted as United Nations Regulation No. 165. In accordance with paragraph 4  
of article 1 of the Agreement, the date of entry into force of United Nations Regulation No. 165 for all  
Contracting Parties is 19 January 2023 with the exception of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and  
Northern Island.
