The Russian Federation confirms that it continues to be a signatory to the CTBT and to participate in the work of the Preparatory Commission for the CTBT Organization (CTBTO PC).

I ask you, in your capacity as depositary of the Treaty, to inform the states that have signed the Treaty, as well as the Executive Secretary of the CTBTO PC, about what is stated in this letter.
