KAZAKHSTAN: ACCESSION TO THE CONVENTION AS AMENDED BY THE PROTOCOL

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 3 September 2024, with:

Reservation (Original: English)

“The Republic of Kazakhstan undertakes obligations for the implementation of Article 5 of the
Convention only within the framework of its existing national legislation.”

The Convention entered into force for Kazakhstan on 3 September 2024, in accordance with its
article 9 which stipulates:

“Accession shall be effected by an instrument communicated to the Secretary-General of the
United Nations to be deposited in the archives of the Secretariat. The Secretary-General shall at once
notify such deposit to Members of the United Nations and to the non-member States to which the
Secretary-General has communicated a copy of the Convention.”
