EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE
OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY INLAND WATERWAYS (ADN)

GENEVA, 26 MAY 2000

PROPOSAL OF CORRECTIONS TO THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS
TO THE REGULATIONS ANNEXED TO THE ADN¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

At its thirty-second session (30 August 2024), the ADN Administrative Committee adopted corrections to the proposed amendments communicated to Contracting Parties by depositary notifications C.N.217.2024.TREATIES-XI.D.6 of 1 July 2024 (ECE/ADN/70) and C.N.335.2024.TREATIES-XI.D.6 of 1 September 2024 (ECE/ADN/70/Add.1). The secretariat was requested to publish them as a corrigendum to document ECE/ADN/70 (ECE/ADN/70/Corr.1) and as a corrigendum to document ECE/ADN/70/Add.1 (ECE/ADN/70/Add.1/Corr.1) and to arrange for their communication to Contracting Parties on 1 October 2024 for acceptance in accordance with the usual procedure for corrections so that they could become effective by 1 January 2025 (ECE/ADN/72, para. 21 (b)).

Unless there is an objection from interested Parties, the Secretary-General proposes to correct the text of the proposed amendments to the Regulations annexed to the ADN accordingly.

In accordance with established practice, objections should be communicated to the Secretary-General within 90 days from the date of this notification, not later than 30 December 2024.
