PROPOSAL OF CORRECTIONS TO THE REGULATIONS ANNEXED TO THE ADN

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The ADN Administrative Committee has drawn the attention of the Secretary-General to certain errors in the text of the Regulations annexed to ADN and requested that the corresponding corrections be transmitted to Contracting Parties so that they become effective at the latest by 1 January 2025 (ECE/ADN/72, para. 21 (c)).

The texts of the proposed corrections are contained in annex II of the report of the ADN Safety Committee on its forty-third session (22-26 January 2024) (ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.2/88).
