UNITED NATIONS REGULATION No. 171. UNIFORM PROVISIONS
CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF VEHICLES WITH REGARD TO DRIVER
CONTROL ASSISTANCE SYSTEMS (DCAS)

ENTRY INTO FORCE OF UNITED NATIONS REGULATION No. 171 ¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification
C.N.103.2024.TREATIES-XI.B.16 of 22 March 2024 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to
the Governments of the Contracting Parties the text of draft United Nations Regulation No. 171, none
of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement notified the Secretary-General of their intention not to
apply the said United Nations Regulation on the date of its entry into force, pursuant to paragraphs 3
and 4 of article 1 of the Agreement.

Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 3 of article 1 of the Agreement, the draft United
Nations Regulation is adopted as United Nations Regulation No. 171. In accordance with paragraph 4
of article 1 of the Agreement, the date of entry into force of United Nations Regulation No. 171 for all
Contracting Parties is 22 September 2024.
