NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- Through Supreme Decree No. 104-2024-PCM<sup>1</sup>, dated 2 October 2024, a state of emergency was declared, for a period of 60 calendar days, from 3 October to 1 December 2024, in the population centres of Yanamonte and Carhuahuran in the District of Uchuraccay, Province of Huanta, Department of Ayacucho; and in the population centre of Cochabamba Grande in the District of Cochabamba Grande, Province of Tayacaja, Department of Huancavelica. In addition, the state of emergency was extended for the same period in the following districts and population centres:

- The state of emergency was declared and extended to enable the armed forces to continue the deployment of military operations and actions aimed at progressively restoring peace in the above-mentioned areas. During the state of emergency, the constitutional rights relating to liberty and security of person, inviolability of the home, and freedom of assembly and movement in the territory, included in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, are suspended.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
