NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 118-2024-PCM, published on 31 October 2024, the state of emergency declared in Corredor Vial Sur Apurímac-Cusco-Arequipa (Apurímac-Cusco-Arequipa Southern Road Corridor), including the five hundred (500) metres adjacent to either side of the road corridor, has been extended for a period of thirty (30) calendar days, starting on 1 November 2024.
- The reason for the extension of the state of emergency is to continue actions to maintain public order and guarantee the constitutional rights of the population along the aforementioned Corredor Vial Sur, for which the exercise of constitutional rights relating to freedom of movement through national territory, to freedom of assembly, and to liberty and security of person, included in paragraphs 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Constitution of Peru, shall be restricted.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
