PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 115-2024-PCM, issued on 24 October 2024, a state of emergency was declared in the Districts of Manitea and Kimbiri in the Province of La Convención, Department of Cusco, for a period of 60 calendar days.
- The reason for the measure is the high incidence of crimes involving illicit drug trafficking, in their various forms, such as arms trafficking and other related crimes, committed by criminal organizations, which affect internal order in those areas of the country, putting the public at risk. As a result, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, freedom of movement through the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, enshrined in paragraphs (9), (11), (12) and (24) (f) of article 2 of the Political Constitution of Peru, and those enshrined in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
