The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 122-2024-PCM, published on 8 November 2024, the Government of Peru extended the state of emergency declared in the province of Pataz of the department of La Libertad for a period of thirty (30) calendar days starting on 10 November 2024.
- The state of emergency was extended owing to the continuing disruption of internal order caused by illegal mining, organized crime and related crimes in the province of Pataz. During the state of emergency, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, freedom of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly and liberty and security of person, as outlined in paragraphs 9), 11), 12) and 24) letter f) of Article 2 of the Political Constitution of Peru, and those included in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, are restricted.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
