CONVENTION ON THE RIGHTS OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES
NEW YORK, 13 DECEMBER 2006

POLAND: OBJECTION TO THE RESERVATIONS MADE BY BHUTAN UPON RATIFICATION ¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 12 March 2025.

“The Government of the Republic of Poland has examined the reservation by the Kingdom of Bhutan to the paragraph 1 (a) and paragraph 2 of Article 18, paragraphs 1 (b) and (c) or Article 23, paragraph 1 (c) of Article 27, and section (a) (ii) of Article 29 of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities done in New York on December 13, 2006, made upon its ratification on march 13, 2024.

The Government of the Republic of Poland considers that the reservation made by the Kingdom of Bhutan according to which it does not consider itself bound by paragraph 1 (a) and paragraph 2 of Article 18, paragraphs 1 (b) and (c) of Article 23, paragraph 1 (c) of Article 27, and section (a) (ii) of Article 29 of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities is incompatible with the object and purpose of the Convention and therefore objects to it. This objection shall not preclude the entry into force of the Convention between the Republic of Poland and the Kingdom of Bhutan.”
