INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 058-2025-PCM,¹ published on 1 May 2025, the Government of Peru extended a state of emergency for a period of sixty (60) calendar days, starting from 6 May 2025, in the districts of Anco and Unión Progreso in the Province of La Mar, Department of Ayacucho, and in the districts of Megantoni, Kumpirushiato, Echarate, Villa Virgen, and Villa Kintiarina in the Province of La Convención in the Department of Cusco.
- The state of emergency was extended due to the high incidence of crimes involving illicit drug trafficking, in various forms, and other related crimes committed by criminal organizations, which affect public order and endanger the population in those areas declared in a state of emergency. In this regard, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, freedom of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, as outlined in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Political Constitution of Peru, and those included in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.
