UNITED NATIONS REGULATION No. 175. UNIFORM PROVISIONS  
CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITH REGARD TO  
THE ACCELERATION CONTROL FOR PEDAL ERROR (ACPE)

ENTRY INTO FORCE OF UNITED NATIONS REGULATION No. 175 <sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification  
C.N.481.2024.TREATIES-XI.B.16 of 23 December 2024 by which the Secretary-General transmitted  
to the Governments of the Contracting Parties the text of draft United Nations Regulation No. 175, none  
of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement notified the Secretary-General of their intention not to  
apply the said United Nations Regulation on the date of its entry into force, pursuant to paragraphs 3  
and 4 of article 1 of the Agreement.

Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 3 of article 1 of the Agreement, the draft United  
Nations Regulation is adopted as United Nations Regulation No. 175. In accordance with paragraph 4  
of article 1 of the Agreement, the date of entry into force of United Nations Regulation No. 175 for all  
Contracting Parties is 23 June 2025.
