UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON THE USE OF ELECTRONIC
COMMUNICATIONS IN INTERNATIONAL CONTRACTS

NEW YORK, 23 NOVEMBER 2005

EL SALVADOR: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 17 July 2025, with:

Declaration (Courtesy Translation) (Original: Spanish)

The Convention shall not apply, in addition to the cases provided for in Article 2, to acts or contracts that require special formalities which, under Salvadoran legislation, cannot be fulfilled through electronic means, until the necessary legal reforms are enacted to enable such possibility.

The Convention shall enter into force for El Salvador on 1 February 2026 in accordance with article 23 (2) which reads as follows:

“When a State ratifies, accepts, approves or accedes to this Convention after the deposit of the third instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession, this Convention enters into force in respect of that State on the first day of the month following the expiration of six months after the date of the deposit of its instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession.”
