INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS  
NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

ECUADOR: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4(3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Ecuador to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, further to note verbale No. 4-2-112/2025 of 17 September 2025, has the honour to inform it of the issuance and entry into force of Executive Decree No. 146 of 18 September 2025,<sup>1</sup> the text of which is annexed hereto, by which the President of the Republic, Daniel Noboa Azín, amended Executive Decree No. 134 of 16 September 2025 and extended the state of emergency to the Province of Chimborazo.

In addition, article 5 of Executive Decree No. 146 provides for the restriction of freedom of transit every day between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. in the Provinces of Imbabura, Chimborazo, Bolívar, Carchi and Cotopaxi, subject to the exceptions set out in that instrument. Consequently, the right established in the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights that has been temporarily suspended is that provided for in article 12 of that treaty.

The duration of the state of emergency continues to be that established in Executive Decree No. 134, namely, 60 days from 16 September 2025.

Pursuant to article 4, paragraph 3, of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Permanent Mission of Ecuador respectfully requests that the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, inform the other States Parties to the Covenant of the issuance and entry into force of Executive Decree No. 134 and of the rights which have been temporarily suspended.
