ECUADOR: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Permanent Mission of Ecuador to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and has the honour to inform it of the issuance and entry into force of Executive Decree No. 175,¹ dated 5 October 2025, the text of which is annexed hereto, by which, due to serious internal unrest, the President of the Republic, Daniel Noboa Azín, extended for an additional 30 days the state of emergency in the Provinces of Guayas, El Oro, Los Ríos, Manabí, and Echeandía Canton in the Province of Bolívar, under the terms set forth in Executive Decree No. 76 of 6 August 2025 as amended by Executive Decree No. 109 of 20 August 2025.

Executive Decrees No. 76 and No. 109 temporarily suspended the right to inviolability of the home and the right to inviolability of correspondence. Consequently, the rights enshrined in the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights the suspension of which has been extended under Executive Decree No. 175 are those provided for in article 17 of that treaty.

Pursuant to article 1 of Executive Decree No. 175, the extension of the state of emergency shall be in effect for 30 days starting on 5 October 2025.

In accordance with article 4, paragraph 3, of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Permanent Mission of Ecuador respectfully requests that the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, inform the other States Parties to the Covenant of the issuance and entry into force of Executive Decree No. 175 and of the rights that have been temporarily suspended.

The Permanent Mission of Ecuador to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
