PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 122-2025-PCM,¹ issued on 2 October 2025, the state of emergency declared in the Province of Pataz of the Department of La Libertad has been extended for a period of 60 calendar days, starting on 6 October 2025.
- This measure has been taken because the problems of illegal mining, organized crime and related offences in the Province of Pataz continue to affect internal order. The regulation provides for the suspension of the exercise of the right to freedom of movement for the carrying out of all mining activities and declares a mandatory social lockdown in the Province of Pataz; in addition, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, enshrined in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Constitution of Peru, and in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
