This measure has been taken in response to the high incidence of crimes involving illicit drug trafficking in its various forms committed by criminal gangs and organizations, which are affecting public order in the areas listed.

As a result, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, liberty of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, enshrined in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Constitution of Peru, and in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.
