EUROPEAN AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTING THE CONVENTION ON ROAD  
SIGNS AND SIGNALS  
GENEVA, 1 MAY 1971

NETHERLANDS (KINGDOM OF THE): NOTIFICATION OF NON-ACCEPTANCE <sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 26 November 2025.

(Original: English)

“... The Permanent Representation wishes to inform the Secretary-General that in the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the constitutional requirements for the acceptance of the above-mentioned amendments will take longer than twelve months. Therefore, in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 2, under a, of the above-mentioned Agreement, the Kingdom of the Netherlands hereby notifies the Secretary-General of its rejection of the above-mentioned amendments.

Once the constitutional requirements for the acceptance of the above-mentioned amendments have been met, the Kingdom of the Netherlands will notify the Secretary-General that it accepts the amendments in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 5, under b, of the above-mentioned Agreement...”
