INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS
NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 030-2026-PCM,¹ issued on 7 March 2026, a state of emergency has been declared for a period of sixty (60) calendar days, from 8 March 2026, in the following jurisdictions of the department of Piura:
 - the districts of Piura, Castilla, Veintiséis de Octubre and Catacaos of the Province of Piura;
 - the districts of Sullana and Bellavista of the Province of Sullana; and
 - the provinces of Paita and Talara.
- This measure was adopted in order to ensure the preservation and/or restoration of internal order in the aforementioned areas, as well as to guarantee the constitutional rights of the population in the face of the incidence of crimes such as illicit drug trafficking, aggravated robbery, and other collateral offences such as contract killing, illegal possession of firearms, among other crimes and situations of violence.
- As a result, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, liberty of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, enshrined in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Constitution of Peru, and in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.
