TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to its Note No. 156 dated July 24, 2025, and Note No. 75 dated April 10, 2026, concerning the declaration and subsequent termination of a State of Public Emergency in the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.

The Permanent Mission has the further honour to inform the Secretary-General that the State of Public Emergency declared on July 18, 2025 by Proclamation (Legal Notice No. 240 of 2025) was extended, in accordance with section 10(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (Chap. 1:01), by resolution of the House of Representatives as follows:

- On July 28, 2025, for a period of three months, as reflected in Legal Notice No. 248 of 2025; and
- On October 31, 2025, for a further period of three months, as reflected in Legal Notice No. 390 of 2025.

The Permanent Mission wishes to advise that the above information is provided in order to complete the record of the State of Public Emergency notified under Article 4, paragraph 3 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of its highest consideration.
