INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS
NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 29 May 2026.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

By Supreme Decree No. 040-2026-PCM,¹ published on 26 March 2026, the state of emergency declared in the twelve (12) districts and eight (8) populated centres (*centros poblados*) detailed below, was extended for sixty (60) calendar days beginning on 27 March 2026:

(*) It should be noted that the declaration only affects the populated centres (*centros poblados*) described above and not the entirety of the respective districts.

This measure was adopted to address crime and other situations of violence in the aforementioned jurisdictions.

The aforementioned Supreme Decree likewise extended the state of emergency in the territorial area known as the “Camisea gas energy hub” (*Eje Energético del Gas de Camisea*), which covers a distance of eight (8) kilometres on each side of the Natural Gas and Natural Gas Liquids Transportation System, starting from the Nuevo Mundo populated centre in the district of Megantoni in the province of La Convención (department of Cusco) until the district of Anco in the province of La Mar (department of Ayacucho). Also included is the territorial area known as the “River-land operational corridor of the Ene River” (*Corredor Operacional Fluvial - Terrestre del Ene*) which covers the territorial area along both banks of the Ene River, in accordance with Annex 2 of the Supreme Decree attached to this notification.

In this regard, in view of the continuity of terrorist activities and other related threats present in the area, and to enable the Armed Forces to continue deploying military actions and operations in the area of responsibility of the VRAEM Special Command (CE-VRAEM), the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to inviolability of the home, freedom of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, set forth in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Political Constitution of Peru, as well as in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
