NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

By Supreme Decree No. 050-2026-PCM,¹ published on 2 April 2026, the state of emergency declared in the Provinces of Putumayo and Mariscal Ramón Castilla (department of Loreto) was extended for a period of sixty (60) calendar days beginning on 6 April 2026.

This extension was adopted in order to address the actions of hostile groups and other related threats, as well as to strengthen control of migration and borders. In this regard, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to inviolability of the home, freedom of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, set forth in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Political Constitution of Peru, as well as in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
